2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Report of 2011

Dear Pastor and Church,

## PERSECUTED BECAUSE OF THE GOSPEL!

1. We traveled 16 hours, visited this Christian couple last December and shared to their village the message about the true meaning of Christmas. Little did we know that it will be our last visit to them. Three days after we came, the village security men visited them, got their American passports and didn't return to them for two months. They were allowed to go back to America, came back here in this place after two weeks, preached to our church on that Sunday, went to Thailand to do some groceries, entered again into this country but the immigration officials told them they entered the country illegally. Our partners were summoned to the immigration office after two days, were accused of drug trafficking, escorted to Thailand and were not allowed to come back again. When we visited them at the border he said, "***Glory to God for all the things He hath done. We may not understand it now why this thing happened but we will in the future.***"

With this kind of real danger of doing God's work I'm reminded of **1 Peter 4:16** *Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.* Please pray for Bro. Chris and Sis. Khet.

2. "*Why are you going to Thailand?*", asked the immigration official to one of our Bible students. Since she's a Christian and doesn't want to lie, she answered, "*I'm going there to study the Bible*". This was the beginning of many questions that eventually led to the decision of the officer not to allow three out of six students to cross the border.

We just praise the Lord that they were not detained. One of our Bible students later told me, *Pastor I'm not afraid to go back to prison because of Jesus.* I'm humbled by their faith and **Mark 10:29-30** came to my mind, "And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, **with persecutions**; and in the world to come eternal life.

## BLESSED BECAUSE OF THE GOSPEL

Pastor, in spite of these persecutions we continue to serve our living God and we are excited to share to you that **many souls got saved during this quarter and we baptized 1 Filipino and 6 local Christians at our "secret backyard baptistry"**.

Yes, doing God's ministry here is a big risk **BUT** it's worth it all!

As we continue to labor in this place **we count it all joy to face different kinds of trials as well as enjoy different kinds of blessings!**

- **SPIRITUALLY**

1. By faith I resigned as a school nurse to focus on our Bible Institute. I started teaching our students every day and together with our local pastor we are excited on how God will use our students in the future in planting local Baptist churches around the country. I praise the Lord for touching the heart of our boss and allow me to go but still sponsored my visa for a year.
2. It's a joy to see one of our Bible students brought five of his friends and one got saved. **We also rejoiced for souls saved during this quarter and 2 Filipinos and 3 locals were added to the church.**
3. We praise the Lord for answering our prayers of another missionary family. Bro. Khoumaly, with his wife Sis. Dee and children, Summer and Hudson. Sis. Jenny and Sis. Bernice went with them as they knew God called them here. **Now we have 4 Baptist families working in this place!**

- **PHYSICALLY**

1. Please pray that God would heal and provide the needs of our beloved co-laborer Sis. Danah. She's been a faithful worker and a big blessing to my family and church. She was diagnosed of a rare disease, Tuberculosis of the Liver.
2. My wife's health. The school just began and the stress level of my wife increased as well as she continues to teach Grade 1 students. She was diagnosed with a thyroid problem, an autoimmune disease before and the number one factor which can trigger it is stress. We needed her work for our visas to stay here legally.
3. Please pray for our protection. One of our member's house was ransacked and all her valuables were stolen. We saw crimes increased radically for the past two years.

- **FINANCIALLY**

1. As the ministries increase so the expenses. We are raising \$30.00 for one student per month for their food allowance alone. Pastor, if God impress into your heart to support one Bible student that would be a great investment.

I'm so glad that our support doesn't depend upon the economy of this world but upon God. Just like Apostle Paul, "My God shall supply all your need" because of your faithfulness in supporting us financially. Thank you for being our rope holders throughout these difficult times.
